



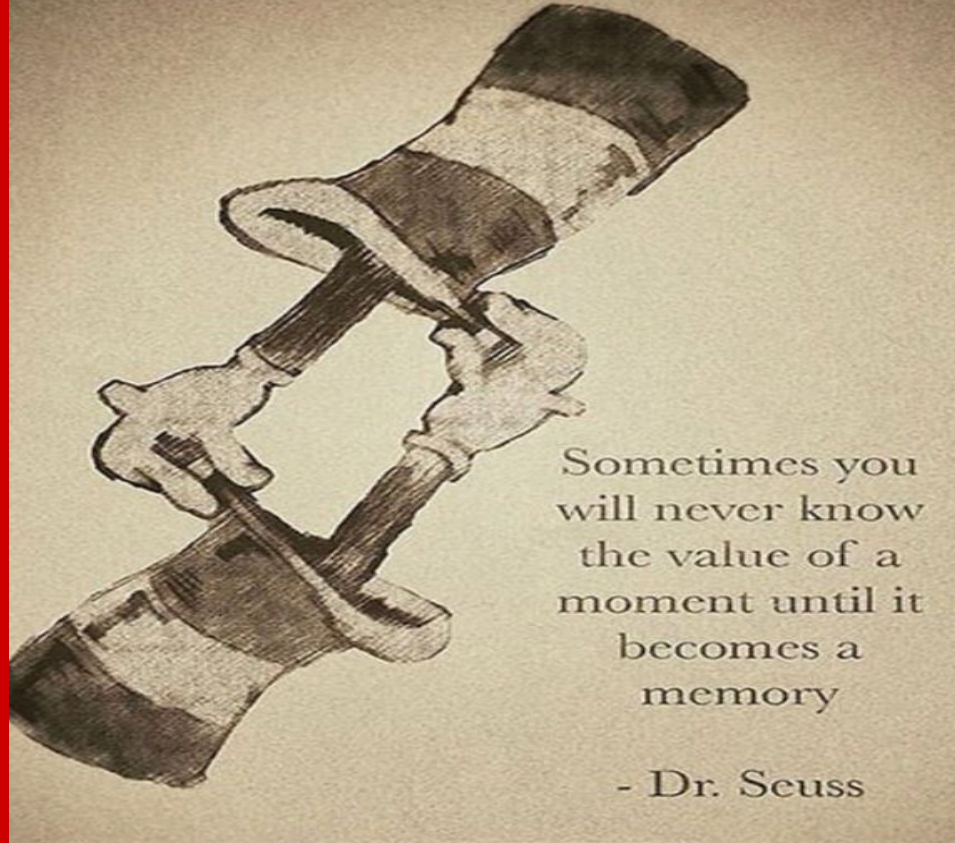

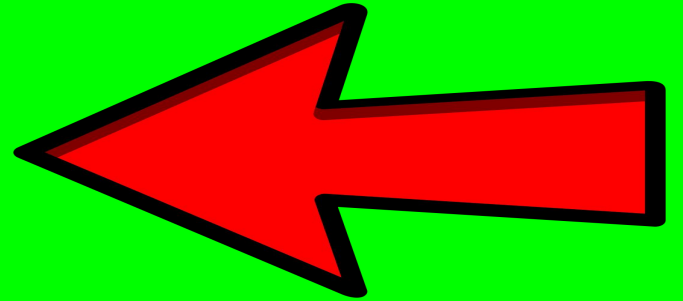
8th - 11th graders interested in playing for the WHS golf teams next year should attend an interest meeting on Monday 5/21 at 3:10 in Room 204 of WHS.

Handbook Changes: Important Information

For 2018-19

School Year



#1 - Students: a change in the dress code for 2018-19 school year regarding holes in pants. For the 2018-19 school year, holes that show skin above the knee (instead of mid-thigh) will not be dress code compliant. Please plan ahead with your wardrobe.

#2 - BYOD Policy update: BYOD was designed for students to bring tablets/laptops/other devices that will improve and/or enhance their learning in the classroom. For the 2018-19 school year, cell phones are no longer approved BYOD devices and therefore it will be at the teacher's discretion to allow cell phones in class. Cell phone docking stations are planned to be provided for each classroom as a place to store your phone if they are not allowed out in class. Appropriate cell phone usage will still be allowed in the lunchroom, before/after school, and during passing periods.

Attention Students:

Beginning 8/28/17

Tardies for the year will be counted and used to determine parking incentives for the 2018-19 school year.

Parking fees will remain \$75, BUT your number of tardies may earn you a discount in addition to determining your raffle order.

**For the 2017-18 School Year
(8/28/17-5/30/18)**

0-2 tardies = free parking spot and eligible for the first rounds of drawing

3-4 tardies = $\frac{1}{2}$ off parking spot and eligible for the second round drawing

5+ tardies = full price parking and eligible for final round in the drawing
